Double Majors: Students may earn a second major in addition to the history major. One of the most popular combinations with the history major is the communication and media major; this combination has been pre-approved through CSLA and the university’s academic process. Completion of the History/Communication and Media double major is often feasible within four years of full-time study. In addition to the requirements for each major and the General University Requirements, students must take enough credits in electives to fulfill the 128-credit degree minimum.
